Agenda for 72nd Session of Council

Public Meeting – Housekeeping Zoning Amendment

The proposed housekeeping amendment was initiated by the Township to correct zone map errors affecting one property in Odessa, four properties in Bath and three properties on Switzerville Road. The public meeting was to hear from any person who claimed to be affected by the application. A recommendation report will be brought forward at a future Council meeting.

Quinte Conservation Authority Presentation

Council supported, by resolution, the objectives outlined in the presentation being: approval, in principle, for the scope of Category 2 and 3 programs and services to be delivered by Quinte Conservation effective 2024; and direction to work with administrative staff on provincially mandated agreements.

Strategic Plan 2022 Dashboard Update

The Strategic Plan 2022 Dashboard Update report and presentation by the Chief Administrative Officer was received with thanks. The Report updates outcomes linked to the 2019-2023 Strategic Plan initiatives.

Appointment of Joint Compliance Audit Committee

By-law 2022-087 was enacted and passed that appointed public members to the Joint Compliance Audit Committee for the 2022-2026 Term of Council.

Odessa Municipal Office Roof Replacement Project

Council received the report on the Results of NRFP 2022-36 – Odessa Municipal Office Roof Replacement and awarded the contract to Amherst Roofing and Sheet Metal Limited.

Babcock Mills Subdivision Phase 3, Lot 43 – Part Lot Control

By-law 2022-084, being a by-law to lift part lot control requirements for Lot 43, Registered Plan 29M-64 for the Babcock Mills Phase 3 Plan of Subdivision, was enacted and passed.

Council supported the resolution circulated by the Municipality of Brighton regarding Change to Healthcare Connect System – Canadian Forces Members.
